
1. How do I access the STOP A STROKE module?

Firstly, launch Audit+ by selecting the Informatica Icon from the PC Desktop:




Then select the 'STOP A STROKE' icon on the screen:









2. How do I view STOP A STROKE Atrial Fibrillation Dashboard?

When the module opens, you will be presented with the following main dashboard status screen:




As you can see, this graphical Atrial Fibrillation Dashboard is split into 4 main sections:

- 1. Number of Patients in the practice with AF
- 2. Number of patients in the practice reviewed in the previous 12 months
- 3. Number of patients in the practice with no review in previous 12 months
- 4. QOF AF prevalence indicators






To ensure that an Atrial Fibrillation review is recorded and subsequently reported correctly in Audt+, then any one of the following three Read Codes can be used:



All of the dashboards in the module are completely interactive, and should you click on any dashboard area, for example, if you wanted to view the 29 patients with no review in the previous 12 months, you would simply double click on the bar chart:







And the following corresponding patient list of names and dates of birth will present:

Similarly, if you wanted to know which patients were on Warfarin, you would select the Warfarin tab and see that patient list.

From the patient list, please note that all the usual standard Audit+ functionality is available, for example, Export to Excel, etc:



Plus their corresponding Function buttons at the bottom of the screen:






3. How do I view the STOP A STROKE Atrial Flutter Dashboard?

If you look at the top of the dashboard screen you will note that the next tab is the Atrial Flutter dashboard. You can access this, along with all the other tabs, by simply clicking on the tab area to select:



You will then be presented with the Atrial Flutter Dashboard:








4. How do I view Patient Lists for Anti-Coagulation status and review?

Whilst you can launch patient lists directly from the interactive dashboards for patient names and dates of birth (as described in pages 3 and 4), you can also launch full patient lists for review from their corresponding tabs.

For example, if you wanted to review the full list of patients and their status in Atrial Fibrillation, this will show you not just the patient names and dates of birth, but their anti-coagulation status as well in order that they can be reviewed:









5. How do I view Patient Lists for QOF Atrial Fibrillation and Atrial Flutter prevalence review?

Again, simply by selecting the required tab, either AF Prevalence or Flutter Prevalence:



NB: the standard Audit+ functionality buttons are available to use from all patient list screens:
